**Dr Hugh McDougall, MB, FRCS**

Thank you for your enquiry concerning the above-mentioned Dr Hugh McDougall. I have been able to elicit some details about his medical studies at Glasgow University and these are set out below for your information. I have also made photocopies of prize list entries featuring Dr McDougall which I thought might be of interest to you

Our records show that Hugh McDougall matriculated on four separate occasions for the academic years 1876-7, 1877-8, 1878-9 and 1879-80. His matriculation numbers for these years were, respectively, 123, 603, 1782 and 164. Some biographical information given in these entries which might be of use to you is that he is recorded as being 19 (on his latest birthday) in the first matriculation entry and 22 in the last. I have also included a photocopy of one of the entries which gives you a sample of his handwriting and signature, as well as giving you the name of his father and the latter's occupation.

From our class lists, I am able to give you a summary of the classes he attended during the course of his studies, and, in some cases, even the name of the Professor who taught him. These are as follows:
