Born : Edinburgh 1892

Died : Elie, Fife 1959

_____ a Scottish Watercolourist, whose principal productive period lay between the early 1920's and the 1950.s.

His work embraced mainly the Highlands and the East Neuk of Fife.

Trained at Edinburgh College of Art, he served throughout the First World War and subsequently taught professionally in

Barnstable Grammar School, (Devon).

Dollar Academy, (Clackmannanshire).

Edinburgh Ladies College, (now part of Daniel Stewarts College).

He exhibited regularly in the

RSA (Royal Scottish Academy),

RSW (Royal Society of Watercolourists)

SSA (Society of Scottish Artists)

and the Glasgow Fine Arts Society

Those who would have been contemporary artists include D.Y.Cameron, Stanley Cursitor, Adam Bruce Thompson, T Elder Dickson, Arthur Dodds and James Gray.
