BEATON, Donald	Tiree Aug 1746 Glasgow 4 Feb 1747	Discharged 15 Jul 1747	Was with ye rebels 2 or 3 days and knows not the Regiment. When examined he was found to be one of a group of men who denied being concerned with the Rising and who were guilty of habitual stealing.
MacLEAN, Allan (1)	Tiree Aug 1746 Dumbarnton Castle Glasgow 4 Feb 1747	Discharged 15 Jul 1747	Maclean of Drimminns Regiment
MacLEAN, Allan (2)	Tiree Aug 1746 Dumbarnton Castle Glasgow 4 Feb 1747	Discharged 15 Jul 1747	Maclean of Drimminns Regiment
MacLEAN, Archibald (1)	Tiree Aug 1746 Dumbarnton Castle Glasgow 4 Feb 1747	Discharged 15 Jul 1747	Maclean of Drimminns Regiment. Of Balenmartine 'says he was not with the rebels', 'was recruiting men in company with Maclean of Drimmin and when the Duke of Argyll's factor went to the country to raise the Militia, openly opposed him and threatened to mob him'. Apprehended by a party sent by General Campbell.
MacLEAN, Archibald (2)	Tiree Aug 1746 Dumbarnton Castle Glasgow 4 Feb 1747	Discharged 15 Jul 1747	Maclean of Drimminns Regiment. Of Senddig 'says he was not with the rebels', 'was recruiting men in company with Maclean of Drimmin and when the Duke of Argyll's factor went to the country to raise the Militia, openly opposed him and threatened to mob him'. Apprehended by a party sent by General Campbell.
MacLEAN, Hector	Tiree Aug 1746 Dumbarnton Castle Glasgow 4 Feb 1747	Discharged 15 Jul 1747	Servant to James Reid. Forced into rebellion by his master. Ferried nineteen men from Tiree to join the rebels. Was at Culloden with Maclean of Drimminns Regiment.
MacLEAN, John	Tiree Aug 1746 Dumbarnton Castle Glasgow 4 Feb 1747	Discharged 15 Jul 1747	Of Kerway.
MacLEAN, Neill	Tiree Aug 1746 Dumbarnton Castle Glasgow 4 Feb 1747	Discharged 15 Jul 1747	
MacVURRISH/McCOURICH /McWARRISH, Malcolm (A Dr John McWARRISH from Drunley, Moirdart was a surgeon in the Jacobite Army).	Tiree Aug 1746 Dumbarnton Castle Glasgow 4 Feb 1747	Discharged 15 Jul 1747	Of Balenanoch
MCDUGALL, Neil	Tiree Aug 1746 Dumbarnton Castle Glasgow 4 Feb 1747	Discharged 15 Jul 1747	Pilot of Scarinish, Tiree to the French ships which came into Lochnanuagh [Loch nan Uan] in Arisdig in May 1746. Was with Maclean of Drimminn levying men.
MCDONALD, John (alias McILLINIAN)	Tiree Aug 1746 Dumbarnton Castle Glasgow 4 Feb 1747	Discharged 15 Jul 1747	Of Tiree "says he was with the rebels 2 or 3 days before Culloden". As a matter of fact he attended Maclean of Drimmin when recruiting on the island.
