in having on the 8<sup>th</sup> August 1868 gone in a Boat assisted by  
a crew of Seven men to the relief of three of the Crew of the "Maria  
Fanny" wrecked at Balephuil Bay, Island of Sycro, Scotland, whose  
lives they saved, calls forth the admiration of this General Court, and  
justly entitles him to the Honorary Silver Medal of this  
Institution which is hereby awarded.
