† A. You are hereby informed that by their decision dated the _____ day of _____, the ²[Local] Pension ²[Sub-] Committee have allowed your claim to a pension, and that you will be entitled to a pension at the weekly rate of _____ shillings, the first payment in respect of which will be due on Friday the _____ day of _____.

† B. You are hereby informed that by their decision dated the 13th day of May 1915, the ²[Local] Pension ²[Sub-] Committee have provisionally allowed your claim to a pension and that the provisional allowance of your claim will take effect on the ³ 19th day of May 1915, unless before that date an application is made for the revocation or alteration of the provisional allowance. If the provisional allowance takes effect, you will be entitled to a pension at the weekly rate of five shillings, the first payment in respect of which will be due on Friday the 21st day of May 1915.

The Pension Officer will in due course issue to you a book of pension orders enabling you to obtain payment of the pension at the Post Office at Ruaig.

The pension will continue so long only as you fulfil the statutory conditions and are not subject to any disqualification.

This decision is subject to appeal to the Local Government Board by the Pension Officer or any person aggrieved. If an appeal is made by any person other than yourself or a person appealing on your behalf you will be informed of the fact.

Should you desire to appeal against this decision you may do so by sending notice of appeal to the Local Government Board not later than seven days after the receipt of this notice, and sending at the same time to me notification that you have so appealed. A form of notice of appeal and a form of notification may be obtained on application to me.
