Neither lineage relates to any clan Maclean genealogies.

I've researched both lines back to 1720's and can find no connection between Alastair the author & Donald the spy.

- Registrar. 1881 records the family at Moss. Dau Mary who would later marry Archibald Lamont, was Sewing Mistress, her younger sister Margaret was a Pupil Teacher.
- In 1891, John, Margaret & dau Janetta are recorded at Moss. Janetta is now the Sewing Mistress. Also in the household are grandchildren Mary Harriet McFarlane 5 & Duncan T McFarlane 4, both born Japan. Their father was
- So, as she lived in Tyree for nearly 20 years, Mary McFarlane would likely have known/met her future husband Archibald Lamont, who is recorded at Barrapool 1871 & 1881, Archibald Lamont b1839, was s/o Archibald Lamont, Crofter, (b1802 Balevullin-d4 Mar 1864 Gortendonnel), & Margaret Sinclair (1809-18 Jun 1868).
- Archibald Lamont b1802 was s/o Alexander Lamont (b1760 Kenovay) & 2nd wife Margaret McDonald b1775 Balevullin. Alexander Lamont was s/o Donald Lamont c1724-1805 Kenovay & unknown 1st wife.

Duncan McFarlane, Mariner born Dec 1850 Port Charlotte Islay, eidest child of John & Margaret.

- In 1901, John McFarlane is recorded a Widower at Saracen St Maryhill Glasgow, 'Superannuated School Master'.

- Rev Alexander McLean b1885, was s/o Lachlan McLean of Moss & Mary McVean, Lachlan was born 12 Oct 1852, son of Alexander McLean b1803 d1 Nov 1870 Moss, Shoemaker, & Janet Black 1809-26 Mar 1862 Moss. Janet was from Bunessan in Mull, her parents were Lachlan Black & Elizabeth Stewart who were married at Ardtun on 26 May 1807.

Alexander McLean 1803-1870 was s/o Archibald McLean b1764 & Margaret McPhail, Helipol. Archibald McLean b1764 was s/o Donald Mclean b1729 & Mary Lamont, of Helipol

Donald Duart McLean 'Spy' was born 25 May 1913 Marylebone London England & d 6 Mar 1983. His father was Sir Donald Mclean, Liberal Party MP. Sir Donald was born 9 Jan 1864 at Farnworth in Lancashire, his father was John McLean, Shoemaker of Kilmoluaig Tyree.

John McLean, Shoemaker, was born 27 May 1833 at Kilmoluaig, s/o Hugh McLean (1794 Kenovay -2 May 1867 Kilmoluaig) & Cath McDonald (1799 Hough-24 Apr 1886 Kilmoluaig). Hugh b1794 Kenovay, was a Crofter, his parents were Hugh McLean b1749 Cornaigmore & Margaret McLean born c1757 Cornaigbeg.
