Baugh House, Island of Sui
Sept 5th 1929.

agree to carry out my wishes. I make no
will.

I wish my dear, beloved, Sister Annie (or Nana) to
have the full use of interest on my money invested
in New Zealand, for her life. Afterwards the money
that may be mine to be equally divided between
my three sons, but £100. to be given to my brother
D^r Douglas MacLaurane, for his own private ~~use~~ and
entire use. Not to be handed down to his family.

Nana to have full control of all my belongings
except a few articles. I specially wish the boys to get
as given direct from myself.
