

The death took place on the 19th February of Mrs. Ronald A. McLean. Colonside. Linnithgow, at the age of 90 years. His funeral was from St. Merian's - Craigmailen Church on Saturday morning.

A Gaelic speaking native of the Hebridean Island of Linn, Mrs McLean came to Linnithgow in 1911. He worked in St. Magdalene's Distillery before joining the West Lothian Constabulary in 1912. When he retired in 1952, he had served as Constable, sergeant, detective inspector, superintendent and deputy chief constable.

He married a Linnithgow lady Euphemia Skoddatt, and their eldest child Charles lost his life in the R.A.F. in 1941. He is survived by a family of 1 son and 3 daughters.
