Roll of Honour

THE names of all the members of His Late Majesty's Forces who fell in the 1939-1945 War will be printed in cemetery and memorial Registers. Copies will be kept at the War cemeteries and memorials, and at some public libraries.

The Registers will be divided into parts, which will be bound in stiff paper covers, each part containing about 1,000 names. They will be printed on fine paper and, in addition to the names, will contain maps; plans and descriptions of the cemeteries and memorials; directions for reaching them; and historical surveys of the campaigns from which they resulted.

The length of the entry for each name varies in accordance with the details supplied to the Commission by the relatives and the Record Offices.

The following entry (which does not relate to any known casualty) is printed *as a specimen only*, so that you may judge how the names will be shown.
