This Certificate is given upon an **Ordinary Examination** passed at *Cardiff* on the *16<sup>th</sup>* day of *June* 18*93*

Every person who makes, or procures to be made, or assists in making any false Representation for the Purpose of obtaining for himself or for any other Person a Certificate either of Competency or Service, or who forges, assists in forging, or procures to be forged, or fraudulently alters, assists in fraudulently altering, or procures to be fraudulently altered, any such Certificate or any Official Copy of any such Certificate, or who fraudulently makes use of any such Certificate or any Copy of any such Certificate which is forged, altered, cancelled, suspended, or to which he is not justly entitled, or who fraudulently lends his Certificate to or allows the same to be used by any other person, shall for each offence be deemed guilty of a Misdemeanor, and may be summarily punished by imprisonment with or without hard labour for a period not exceeding Six Months, or by a penalty not exceeding £100, and any Engineer who fails to deliver up a Certificate which has been canceled or suspended is liable to a penalty not exceeding £50.

N.B.—Any person other than the Owner thereof becoming possessed of this Certificate is required to transmit it forthwith to the Registrar General of Shipping and Seamen, London, E.C.
