The Merchant Shipping Act, 1894, further requires the Master to notify, as above, any assignment or cancellation of the Indenture or the death or desertion of the Apprentice.

The fee for registration of an Apprentice's Indenture is 2s. 6d.

Directions for Signing Deeds.

The parties subscribe at the marks* on the right-hand side, in presence of two witnesses above fourteen years of age, who will sign at the marks† on the left side, each adding after his signature the word witness.

Two witnesses are sufficient to the subscription of any number of parties, provided these parties sign the deed at the same time and place; but if signed at different times or places two witnesses are requisite to each separate subscription.
