

Ancestral Homesteads of Tiree 25 April, 2006 [Blue indicates known homesteads]

1. **Caoles: MACDOUGALL (McLucas) Charles and Mary Morrison** of Port Ban, Caoles m. 1785, Mull
Catriona Smyth knows where their house is (a current residence). Ancestors of PM Joe Clar,
 2. **Ruaig: MACDOUGALL, Donald** s/o Charles (above) of Caolis and **Marion (Sarah) McLean** of Ruaig m Jan 27, 1830
Catriona Smyth knows of a ruins that may be theirs in Ruaig. (emigrated 1846). These are the ancestors of PM Joe Clark.
 3. **Ruaig: CLARK, Hugh and Christy McLean** (sister of Sarah above) m. 19 Feb 1812 in Ruaig.
Catriona Smyth might know where they lived because the sisters lived very close to each other, being enumerated next to each other in the 1841 census (emigrated about 1846). These are the ancestors of PM Joe Clark.
 4. **Baugh/Ruaig: MCLEAN, John and Margaret McLean** m. 19 July 1791 in Baugh:
Two of their daughters are Joe Clark's Ancestors (see above, Christy [McLean] Clark and Sarah [McLean] McDougall. It is possible, because in 1841 John McLean, age 80, is living with his daughter Sarah (McLean) McDougall, that this was the location of the McLean homestead in Ruaig. (Sarah was living in Ruaig at marriage and most of her children are born in Ruaig.) But where was the McLean homestead in Baugh? There were two John/Margaret McLean families in Baugh!
 5. **Caoles: CLARK, Neil** (brother of Hugh above) of Ruaig and **Mary McLean** of Ruaig m. 21 Jan 1835.
Neil later moved to Caolis and was there in 1867 when he wrote the letter to his nephew Donald Clark in Tiverton, Ont., who was the great-grandfather of PM Joe Clark. Neil was presumably still living in the same place in Caoles when he died in 1881.
 6. **Caoles: CLARK, John** (father of Hugh and Neil above) and Mary Lamont m. 3 May 1782 in Ruaig.
These are the direct Clark ancestors of PM Joe Clark. Perhaps John's eldest son, Hugh, inherited John's croft in Ruaig?

7. **Balephuill: MCLEAN, Donald and Ann McLean** of Manitoba House. Parents of Bard John McLean of the Brandon Hills, Manitoba.
 - i. This is the current home of the MacArthurs with the Manitoba sign in the window.

8. **Balemeanach: MCLEAN, Donald** of Balemeanach and **Ann McLean** of Balemeanach m. 6 March 1815 and all children born in Balemeanach. Their daughter, Flora McLean, married Bard John McLean in Tiverton, Ont. She is the "Flora" mentioned in the Bard's "Manitoba Song". Ancestor of Louiise MacDougall.

9. **Sandaig: McARTHUR, Hugh** and **Mary McLean** m. 1770. Children Archibald, Alexander, Donald, Catherine and Flora. Ancestry of Gail Rothlin and Louise MacDougall
10. **Hough/Moss: McNEIL, Lachlan** father appears to come from Mull. Son Donald McNeil b 1838. Two daughters, Mary & Flora, each marry an Archibald McArthur. Ancestry of Gail Rothlin.
11. **Balemeanach: McARTHUR, Donald** m.c. 1811 **Flora McLean**. 6 children emigrated 1851 to Brock Twp. then 1852 to Kincardine Twp. Flora, Neil, Peggy, Charles, Donald, Marion. Ancestry of Louise MacDougall.

12. **Cornaigbeg: LAMONT: Peter** and **Ann McLean**. To Brock Township on the Conrad 1851, then to Kincardine Twp. This homestead should be known to the Archive as "Peter's Croft". Ancestry of Louise MacDougall.
13. **Balevullin: CAMERON, Hugh** and Flora McFarlane of Kilkenneth m. 01 Sept 1819 Hugh's father was Duncan Cameron. Ancestors of Babs Humphrey.
14. **Grianall/Kilkenneth: MCFARLANE, Neil** and **Marion McLean** m. 05 Aug 1786 in Grianall. They had John, Ann, Catharine all born at Grianall. Catharine, Flora, John and Ann all born at Kilkenneth and Kilkennethbeg. Ancestors of Babs Humphrey.
15. **Grianall/Kilkenneth?: MCLEAN, Donald** and **Marion McCaulrig** m. before 1786. Parents of Marion McLean above (#2). Ancestors of Babs Humphrey.

16. **Salum: MCKINNON, Fingon** of Salum and **Christena McLean** of Ruaig m. 1 Feb 1832.

Christena was d/o Charles Mclean Ruaig and Ann McLeod 28 April 1801. Ancestors of Archie MacKinnon of Gruelph and Allison McKinnon and Russ McGillivray. Probably the homesteads of these 2 families are already known to the Archive.

17. **Ruaig: MCKINNON, Archibald** and Ann McLean m. about 1778 in Ruaig.
Parents of Fingon McKinnon above. Ancestors of Russ McGillivray, Archie MacKinnon, Allison McKinnon and Alastair Sinclair. Probably the homestead of this family is already known to the Archive.
 18. **Kirkapoll, etc.: MCKINNON, Donald** and **Margaret McPhaden** 11 Jul 1815 Kirkapoll. Moved around: Kirkapoll, Belpetrish, Vaull, Baugh. Ancestors of Russ McGillivray, Arhcie MacKinnon, Elwood McKinnon.
 19. **Kenovay: MCDONALD, Alexander** m **Marion McKinnon** about 1798. All children born Kenovay.
Ancestors of Russ McGillivray and Ellwood McKinnon.
 20. **Kenovay: MCDONALD, Alexander** of Kenovay and **Jane McLean** of Kilmaluag m 26 Mar 1834. Parents of Alex. are Alexander McDonald and Marion McKinnon. See another son Donald McDonald below in #15. Alexander is ancestor of Russ McGillivray & Archie MacKinnon through his second marriage to Sarah McKinnon, daughter of Donald McKinnon, see #13 above.
 21. **Ruaig: LAMONT, Donald** and **Christy Clark** m 07 July 1807 in Ruaig. Christy is a sister of Hugh and Neil Clark and d/o John Clark and Mary Lamont of Ruaig, the ancestors of PM Joe Clark. Then Christy's dau. Elizabeth Lamont m. Donald McDonald of Cornaigbeg (son of Alex. McDonald and Marion McKinnon, see #14) . They live in Cornaigbeg then emigrate late 1840s to Ont. Their dau. Ann McDonald marries (1) about 1854, Tiverton, Malcolm Clark who is her second cousin and the brother of Charlie Clark, g-gf of PM Joe Clark, and (2) Hugh McKinnon, 1866, son of Fingon McKinnon #11. Ancestry of Allison McKinnon, Louise MacDougall, Glenda Franklin.
 22. **Baugh: MCLEAN, Hector** of Kenovay and **Catharene McKinnon** of Vaul m. 18 Dec 1813.
10 children born up till 1833 in Baugh. Family then disappears until daughter Helen marries in Glasgow in 1853.
Ancestors of Eleanor Lillico and Dorothy Pratt, who wonder what became of the family 1833-1853?

23. **Cornaigmore: MCCALLUM, John** and family,

the miller at Cornaigmore in 1776 and thereafter, including in the 1779 census. The homestead should be at the location of the old mill. Ken has a copy of the tack from the Duke of Argyll in 1776. Ancestor of Ken McCallum.

24. **Caolis: MCPHAIDEN, Donald and Flory McNeil** in the 1779 census with children Donald, Mary, Katherine and Mary. Ancestors of Ken McCallum, and of research interest to Glenda Franklin and Louise MacDougall.
25. **Caolis: MCLEAN, John and Mary McDonald in 1779 census with** children Hector, Marion, Flory and Christian
26. Ancestors of Ken McCallum

27. **Caolis/Kirkapol: MCPHAIDEN, Hugh and Ann McDonald** m. 01 June 1812 both of Caolis. Hugh d. 1879 Kirkapol. Son Neil married Hughina McKay 06 Nov 1851. Ancestors of Glenda Franklin who wonders if a descendant of Hugh's is still living on Tiree because Hugh (1788-1879), then son Neil (1818-1907) remained at Kirkapol. Neil's children were Jessie, Catherine (maybe married Donald McLean), Isabella, Harriet, John (alive in 1907), Hector, Ann. Ancestors of Glenda McPhadden Franklin
28. **Salum/Cornaigbeg: 3 MCLEAN Sisters, Flora, Effie, Mary** d/o Neil McLean and Christina McDonald of Cornaigbeg who m. **3 McPhaidens: Donald and Neil** (s/o Hector and Margaret McFadyen of Salum) and their cousin **Donald** (s/o Donald McFadyen and Effy McKinnon, Heanish). To Sask. 1885, Regina/Wapella. Research interest of Glenda Franklin.
29. **Caolis: MCPHAIDEN, Charles and Christy McPhail** m about 1779. Was their homestead the croft at Croish? Son Alexander McPhaden of Caoles, emigrated 1806 to Kenyon Twp, Glengarry County, Ont Ancestor of Glenda Franklin.
30. **Miodar, Caoles: MCPHAIDEN, John and Flora McLean** m 1810 and m 1815 **Christy McLean** of Cornaigbeg. Lived Miodar. Ancestor of Glenda Franklin.
31. **Caoles/Grainall: MCPHAIDEN, Donald** m **Mary McDougall** 22 Sep 1814 both of Caoles. Then lived Grainall, then Caoles. Donald and children emigrated to Tiverton 1851. Son Archie m. Annie McLean. After her death, Archie and children moved to Mantioba – Brandon, Langenburg, Shellmouth. Ancestry of Glenda Franklin, Louise MacDougall, Catriona Smyth.

32. **Vaul, MCPHAIDEN, Roderick** m **Catharine McKinnon** 21 Aug 1810. 6 children to Canada 1851 on Conrad, settled in Kincardine and Bruce Twps. Malcolm & Sandy later settled in Shellmouth, Manitoba. Roderick son of son of Donald McPhaiden & Catherine McLean, Vaul. Research Interest of Louise MacDougall. See also Rev. Alex MacFadyen #27.

33. **Brock Township Emigrants from Salum, Vaul, Ruaig: MCPHAIDEN** emigrated 1821-1867 to Brock Township, Ont. Including descendants of Alexander McPhaiden and Mary McLean of Salum:
- i. 1821 Donald McPhaiden (1782-1865), wife Catherine McNaughton and seven children.
 - ii. 1821 Charles McPhaiden 1790 Ruaig, wife Mary McLean and family.
 - iii. 1821 Archibald/Roderick McPhaiden (1770-1856) Salum and wife Marion/Sarah McKinnon of Baugh and family.
 - iv. 1831 Lachlan McPhaden (1795-1883) Salum and his new bride Catherine McPhaiden of Salum.
 - v. 1820's-1830's Alexander McFadyen (1822-1899) came to Canada with his family. Brock to Osprey. Bagpiper
 - vi. 1842 Charles McPhaden (1815-1851) son of Donald of Caoles, and his wife Helen (nee Currie/McPhaden) and family.
 - vii. 1840's Neil McFadyen (abt 1815) came to Canada with his parents, as did his wife Mary McKinnon. They married in Canada. Brock to Osprey.
 - viii. 1847 Angus McPhaden (1800-) Salum, wife Catherine McKinnon and six children. First to Brock, then Bruce.
 - ix. 1867 Rev. Alexander MacFadyen (1831-1907) Vaul. Wife Mary MacLean of Skye, son Dan.
 - x. Research interest of Glenda McPhadden Franklin & Louise MacDougall.
