

GEORGE A. HOLLEYMAN, FSA – GLASS SLIDES

Box of slides

These consist of most of the pictures in the George Holleyman Collection held at An Iodhlann (the photographs were made either from negatives in the photograph album in the possession of Mrs Jill Scully, or from these slides). The captions to the slides are often less detailed – they may have been prepared for a slide show. For example, No. 23 is captioned 'Cottages at Middleton', rather than 'Tigh tugh, Greenhill' as in the album.

Those included are:

1, 2*, 3, 4, 5, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 22 (2 copies), 23, 24, 25, 26*, 27, 29, 30 (the photograph is from Erskine Beveridge's book *Coll and Tiree*), 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42*, 43, 44, 45 (another photo from Erskine Beveridge's book), 46, 47, 49, 52, 58-62 (the craggan-making sequence), 65. (For no. 63, see note below under New slides.)

* These had been hand coloured, but I was unable to reproduce them in my darkroom in the early 1980s, so scans are now included on the memory stick (see below, also for changes of caption).

Not included are:

6, 8, 13, 20, 21, 28 (this was from a postcard, of which you have a separate copy), 48, 50, 51, 53-57 (showing RAF personnel), 64, 66-76 (mostly photographs taken by Linda Gowans of the trays of artefacts held by An Iodhlann).

On memory stick - Scans of slides from the main box - Archive boxes 1+2

01 Coloured slide of No. 2 from the main collection. Captioned 'Farmstead at Balevullin, Tiree', instead of 'Mary MacLean's tigh tugh' as in the album.

02 A new scan of No. 12 from the main collection, showing the detail on the right to better effect.

03 Coloured slide of No. 26 from the main collection. Captioned 'Ploughing at Balevullin, Tiree', instead of 'Donald Cameron ploughing Mistress Macneil's croft, Balevullin' as in the album.

04 Coloured slide of No. 42 from the main collection. Captioned 'Ruined Temple, Kenavara', rather than 'Peter's Temple and Balephuill Bay' as in the album.

On memory stick - New slides (These are in the small metal box) - Archive box 3

05 Butter Pat, Cord Tightener, Horn Spoon, Tiree. The centre item was used for No. 63 in the main collection, where it was captioned 'Serving mallet made of whalebone found in a ruined cottage in Coalas'. (The other two items were included in No. 64 when photographed by Linda Gowans.)

06 Group of craggans from the article by G. A. Holleyman, 'Tiree Craggans', *Antiquity* 21 (December 1947), 205-11, of which you have a photocopy. The individual craggans shown are captioned: 1 From Sandaig, 2 From Balevullin, 3-6 Made by Hugh MacNeil in 1942. (See the article for more detail.)

07 Map of Scotland.

08 The map of Tiree from Macdougall/Cameron *Handbook to the Islands of Coll and Tiree*.

09 Kenavara, Tiree, coloured slide, photo by G. A. Holleyman, not included in the collection you already have.

10 Lochan at Ruaig, Tiree, coloured slide, photo by G. A. Holleyman, not included in the collection you already have.

11 Seascape, location and photographer unknown.

12 Seascape, location and photographer unknown.

13 Ground Plan of the Broch of Mousa, Shetland, from an unidentified publication.

14 Section of Elevation of the Broch of Mousa, and Broch in Glenelg, from an unidentified publication.

15 Brooches from Benbecula, Skellor and Heisker, Ring from Baleshare, Bone from Machair Leathann. From Erskine Beveridge's book *North Uist*.

Other Glass Slides (In the small metal box – not on memory stick) – Archive box 3

Twelve slides taken from Erskine Beveridge's *Coll and Tiree*. Not included on memory stick as they have simply been photographed from the book. – marked '•' on paper envelope.

(Note – the captions on the glass slides do not show up on the scans on the memory stick.)
