

## APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT UNDER THE DEFENCE REGULATION

Persons making and verifying this application are warned that it is an offence punishable by fine and imprisonment to make in it any untrue statement.

NOTE A.—This Application must be signed by the applicant (see 15 below), and verified (see 16 below) by one of the following, who must be a British subject:—

Mayor, Magistrate, Provost, Justice of the Peace, Minister of Religion, Barrister-at-Law, Solicitor, Notary, Physician, Surgeon, Commissioned Officer of H.M. Forces under whom the applicant is serving, Clerk to a Local Authority.

The verification must be made with personal knowledge of the applicant, and any person signing it without such knowledge is making a false declaration.

NOTE B.—If the Application is for entry to a Protected Area or R.A.F. Station declared a Protected Place the applicant must be in possession of an official document of identity bearing a photograph (i.e. a Green National Registration Identity card, a valid British passport, or an official pass with photograph issued by a Government Department). If the applicant is a British subject and not in possession of one of these documents he should, subject to any special instructions from the Authority or Government Department concerned, obtain from the nearest National Registration Office an application form for a Green Card. If the applicant is registered as an alien his Aliens Registration Certificate will be sufficient.
