Police Report

Duncan Campbell Cottar Ballyvulin, Islnd of Tyree Parish of Tyree and County of Argyll is charged with the crime of Assault in so far as on Saturday the 6th Day of June 1868 years the said Duncan Campbell did Assault Sarah Kennedy or McLean wife of and residing with Donald McLean cottar Ballyvulin Parish and county aforesaid at or near the sea Beach Called Port Aoir situate at Ballyvulin aforesaid and about 140 yards from the house of John Cameron Crofter Ballyvulin by giving the said Sarah Kennedy or McLean a push with his two hands on the breast by which she fell she got up and he did this again and she also fell the second time and complains of being hurt.

Sarah Kennedy wife of and residing with Donald MacLean cotter Ballyvulin says I am about 38 years of age I was at the shore on Saturday the 6th day of June 1868 working at Kelp. Duncan Campbell cotter Ballyvulin was there he commenced to spread his wreck on my ground I told him to go away we quarrelled and he the said Duncan Campbell gave me a push with his two hands I fell, got up and he struck me a second time I fell again I complained very much that night but there is nothing wrong with me now.

Donald McNeil Crofter Ballyvulin say I am about 50 years of age I saw Duncan Campbell, strike Sarah Kennedy and corroborated the whole of what she says
