Sir,

I made all the enquiry possible about the horse mentioned in Mr Campbell's letter being taken away from the Glebe. The horse in question do not belong to the Minister it belongs to his servant man I saw the man and the horse very late on Saturday the 18th July at my house at Heanish it is difficult to know whether the horse was ridden that night or not the horse was grasing with Mr Barr last year and the ministers lad was Barr's servant the horse was in the habit of going to Ballyphetrish and was found grazing that morning along with a number of other horses belonging to Gott, on the field in front of Ballyphetrish House, the whole of the horses that was there belonged to the Farm of Gott, and this horse was in the habit of going with them –

I could not find out any stranger or other person being the way of Scarnish or Gott on the evening of said date
