Police Report

Neil MacMillan son of and residing with Neil M^cMillan Cotter Balevulin Island and Parish of Tyree and County of Argyll is charged with the crime of Assault and Malicious Mischief in so far as on Monday the fourteenth day of Nov Eighteen hundred and seventy years the said Neil MacMillan did remove a sod out of a broken pane in the window of Hector Cameron cotter Balevulin Parish and County aforesaid did remove the screen did expose his person did piss in the eyes and face of Mary MacLean residing with Rachel Brown cotter Balevulin aforesaid did call names to the said Mary MacLean did after that kick the door broke the latch or bar of the door did come in to the house and struck the said Mary MacLean with his hand on the back did kick her with his foot on the ankle did bleed her ankle did strike or kick the said Mary MacLean on the hip and other parts of her body.

Mary MacLean says I am 12 years of age I was in the House of Hector Cameron on the night of Monday the 14th Nov Neil M^cMillan son of Neil MacMillan aforesaid came to the window removed the sod from the pane and pissed in my eyes I called him names he then kicked at the door broke the bar came in and kicked me three kicks and struck me with his hand on the back Catherine Cameron daughter of Hector Cameron rescued me from him

Catherine Cameron daughter of and residing with Hector Cameron Cotter Ballyvulin says I am about 17 years of age and saw the whole of the above.

Neil McMillan is about 17 or 18 years of age
