Police Report

Hugh Campbell 17 years, an Apprentice Shoemaker Son of & residing with John Campbell a Crofter residing at Cornaigmore, Tyree Argyllshire is charged with Assault & Breach of the Public Peace.

Neil Brown 17 years Son of & residing with Susan M^cDonald or Brown a Widow & Crofter residing at Cornaigbeg, and John M^cDonald 17 years Farm Servant to & residing with Neil M^cLean a Carpenter & Crofter, residing at Cornaigmore, Tyree. Argyllshire, are charged , with Breach of the Public Peace.

So far as about 7 P.M. on Monday 12th Nov^r Curr^t. and within the Croft situated at Cornaigbeg aforesaid, and occupied by John M^cCallum residing there, and in front of the Dwelling House situated in said Croft & occupied by the said John M^cCallum.

The said Hugh Campbell conducted himself in a riotous manner. did attack & assault the said John M^cCallum Cornaigbeg aforesaid, and did strike him with his clenched fist on the right shoulder to the injury of his person. Further. time & place aforesaid, The said Hugh Campbell, Niel Brown, and John M^cDonald did conduct themselves in a riotous & outrageous manner and did take away a Cart & a wheelbarrow the property of the said John M^cCallum, & did throw them a considerable distance from the said Dwelling House, and did return several times to the front door of said Dwelling House, & did curse & swear & did put themselves in a fighting attitude towards the said John M^cCallum, and did threaten to do bodily harm to the said John M^cCallum & his Family & did make a great noise and disturbance, to the terror and alarm of all the inmates of the said Family, whereby a large crowd was collected and a Breach of the Public Peace was committed
